EXHIBITION AGREEMENT TERMS

We're excited about showing your work at the Green Line. In order to exhibit, we ask that you understand and agree to the following conditions:

1. It is the artist(s) responsibility to deliver, install, and remove their work according to the dates above. The Green Line Cafe does not cover costs associated with shipping.
2. All work must ready for presentation (i.e. appropriate framing or hanging devices). The Green Line has limited hanging supplies. This is primarily the responsibility of the artist.
3. Artwork is exhibited at the artist's own risk. The Green Line Cafe will take reasonable measures to monitor/protect the artwork, but cannot be responsible for damage or theft. The Green Line does not have insurance for artwork.
4. The artist may publicize the exhibition as they wish. The Green Line will publicize the exhibition through its website, e-mail list, and signage in the shops.
5. The artist will provide support materials such as bio/resume and jpg images and gives the Cafe permission to distribute this information.
6. Artwork may be for sale. Net prices (that is: the amount the artist receives) are determined by the artist. Retail prices will be set according to the artist's net price to reflect a 30% commission to The Green Line Cafe plus 7% PA sales tax, and rounded to the nearest \$5.00. The artist will provide a title/price list. The Green Line Cafe will handle sales transactions and pay the artist with one check at the end of the exhibition dates.
7. By agreeing to show at The Green Line Café, you are agreeing to give us the right to use images of your work (with credit to you, the artist) on promotional materials showcasing art and events at the Green Line Café.
8. The artist will assist the cafe in the repair of the walls at the close of the show.
9. The Green Line Cafe does not have storage space and cannot be responsible for work left behind. At 30 days after the end of the show, any leftover work will become property of the Green Line Cafe and may be disposed of.
10. The artist understands that the purpose of the Green Line Cafe is not the same as a venue such as an art gallery or art institution. The purpose of the Cafe is to serve as a welcoming and neighborly food and meeting place for a diverse clientele that includes adults and children of all cultures. The artist must acknowledge the importance of this distinction, and select work for exhibition accordingly. The Cafe reserves the right to make final decisions about works displayed in the cafe space before or during the dates of the exhibition.
